A small **handbook** with important things to know for those who have recently arrived in **Hässleholms kommun**

The Swedish Migration Board

■ It is the Migration Board that decides on your residence permit and will summon you when you have received a decision.

■ When you get a residence permit, the Migration Board will provide you with a residence permit card.

■ If you live in one of the Migration

Board's facilities and receive a residence offer, the Migration Board will call you to a relocation meeting.

■ You should turn to the Migration Board to submit your application for a residential case.

■ If you arrange your own rental contract, you should at once inform the Migration Board and give them a copy of the contract.

■ If you get a new home address, you should at once notify the Migration Board.

■ When there is a change in your income, you should notify the Migration Board.

The Swedish Tax Agency

- You should report to the Tax Agency to get registered in the Swedish Population Register.
- When you move, you should report your change of address to the Tax Agency.
- You should address yourself to the Tax Agency to apply for an ID card.
- You have to report to the Tax Agency if you get married / divorced, if you become a widow / widower, or if you have children.

The Employment Service

- If you are unemployed, you should contact the Employment service in order to be enrolled.
- You should turn to the Employment Service to apply for an introduction plan and introduction benefit.
- At the Employment Service you can apply for a home equipment loan.

The Swedish Social Insurance Agency

■ As newly-arrived you should register yourself with the Social Insurance Agency.

■ At the Social Insurance Agency you can apply for supplementary introduction benefit / housing benefit.

■ If you have children, you should notify the Social Insurance about who is the recipient of the child allowance.

■ To receive payments, you should report your account information to the Social Insurance.

■ It is at the Social Insurance that you notify and apply for parental allowance.

■ It is at the Social Insurance that you apply for housing allowance.

■ It is at the Social Insurance that you apply for maintenance support for children.

The Pensions Agency

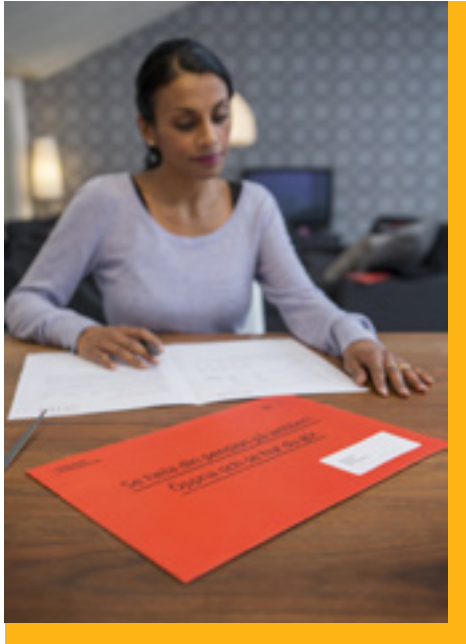

- You can apply for income support at the Social Services Dept.
